The graduates of the program will be were aware of the modern trends ongoing in the field. Educational program will greatly contribute to expanding students' world insight, formation of the taste, as well as development of the analytical skills and imagination. The graduates will train the professionals equipped with practical skills and abilities, being fully able to identify their possibilities in pursuant with modern demands of the market. Bachelor's Program will greatly support preparation of the Graduates for independent creative activity, in the cinematography (fiction, documental) as well as in the direction of TV Art, audio-visual shows, advertising and sound recording studios, audio visual archives services, audio-visual plays and performances. In the frame of the Bachelor's Program in "Audio-Visual Art", learning at the specialty of Cinema Directing and TV Directing includes theoretical and creative-practical aspects, evolving from professional specifics and objectively resulting in the relevant peculiarities of learning.
